- Science in Society – Past, present and future.
- Three Early Modern Novels, (Henry James, Joseph Conrad, Ford Madox Ford).
- Two great West Sussex Houses and 3 to 4 mile walks in the downland settings.
- Vienna the city of Music.
- Words, Music and Drama from Opera.
- Writing Your Own Life Story.
